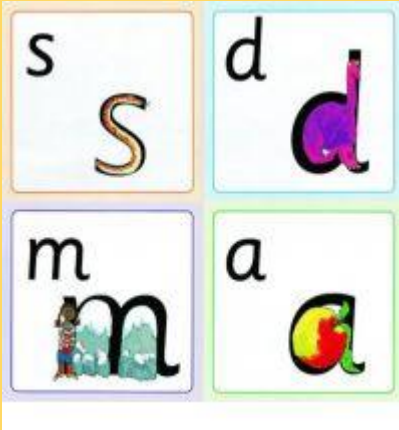

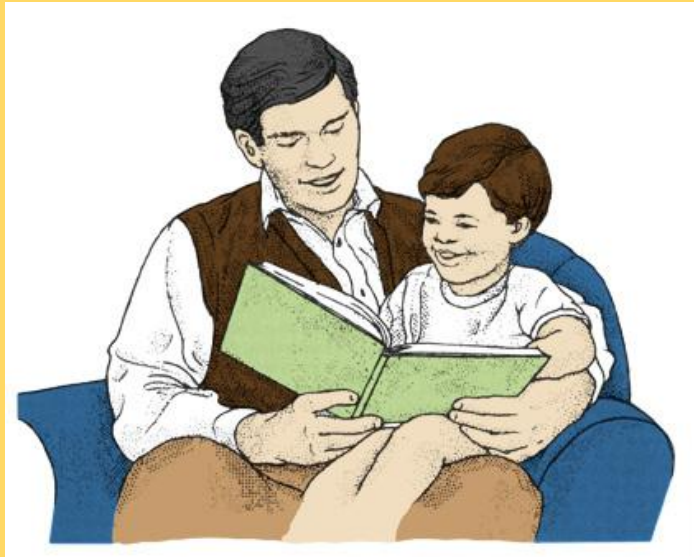

The Simple View of Reading

Children must 'learn to read' before they can 'read to learn'!



What is Phonics?

Phonics is the process by which speech is written down.

- Speech sounds-phonemes
- Written sounds-graphemes
- Decoding

The 5 underlying principles:

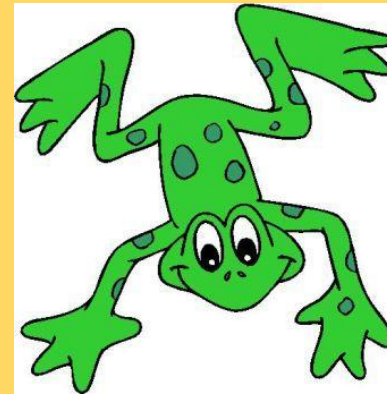
1. Pace

Key Principles of Phonics Teaching

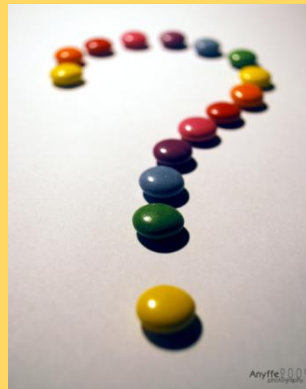
- Breaking words down:
e.g. p l a y h a i r
- Using nonsense words
- 'Red' words - 'grotty graphemes'
- Expect common mistakes in reading and writing at this age
