Dear Parents,

I hope that you and your family remain fit and well. We are all very excited that the school community will once again be reunited on Monday. Please can I ask you to read the updated risk assessment on the school website in the 'Return to School' section. Please do read this in conjunction with the Risk Assessment from October 2020.

When the children return to school, please can you ensure that:

- They bring with them all of their books in which they have been completing home learning tasks. This will enable the class teachers to see where the children are with their studies.
- Only water bottles, wipe clean lunchboxes, homework and reading books are brought into school.
- All parents/grandparents adhere to the one-way system and wear masks when collecting/dropping off their child/children.
- People do not remain on the school site and leave immediately.
- Any IT equipment that has been borrowed is returned to school.
- Homework arrives in school every Monday and reading books are returned every Thursday.
- All children arrive at school between 8.45am and 9am. Please take advantage of this staggered start to avoid congestion.
- Pupils in Reception and Y1 and Y3 are collected at 3.15pm. Pupils in Y2 and Y4 are collected at 3.20pm and pupils in Y5 and Y6 are collected at 3.25pm. Please can you keep any younger children close to you as you wait for their older siblings?

Thank you for your support with this. This will continue to ensure the safety of all of our children and the school staff.

We are looking forward to seeing the work that the children have been completing at home and will be commenting upon this in reports that will be sent home on Friday 26<sup>th</sup> March. Furthermore, staff will be ringing parents during the week 29<sup>th</sup> March to have a brief discussion in relation to these reports.

All after school and before school clubs will begin on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March. Please can all children be collected from their usual school exit door rather than the main entrance?

We very much look forward to seeing you all on Monday morning and working with your children once again. I hope that you all have a lovely weekend.
